

2016-2017 HUMANE ACTION LEAGUE



Humane Action League is an after school program at the Animal Welfare Society on Holland Road in West Kennebunk. **Students spend an hour and a half after school once a week for seven weeks with the Humane Educator.** The program is designed to give students who love animals an opportunity to learn more about the workings of an animal shelter and an introduction on how to become more involved in animal welfare issues. At the start of the program the students will create and sign an agreement with each other about acceptable behaviors, as well as goals for the seven weeks.

Registration for each program opens one month before the start date and is first come first served. Workshop space is limited.

Tuesday Program (ages 12-14) from 2:30 – 4:00PM

Start and End Dates:

- 1st Session: September 6 to October 18
- 2nd Session: October 25 to December 13 (We will not meet 11/22)
- 3rd Session: January 3 to February 14
- 4th Session: February 28 to April 11
- 5th Session: April 25 to June 6

Thursday Program (ages 9-11) from 3:00 – 4:30PM

Start and End Dates:

- 1st Session: September 8 to October 20
- 2nd Session: October 27 to December 15 (We will not meet 11/24)
- 3rd Session: January 5 to February 16
- 4th Session: March 2 to April 13
- 5th Session: April 27 to June 8

Students should bring:

- Appropriate clothing for weather (keep in mind clothes may get dirty!)
- Appropriate footwear (no sandals)
- Appropriate attitudes and a willingness to participate effectively

Fee: \$65.00

Payment of \$65.00 **must be** enclosed with this registration. Forms received without payment will be returned.

If there is no school in Kennebunk, there is no Humane Action League.

Prompt pick up is required. Chronic tardiness may result in your child being removed from the program.
