

Fireworks Safety

Keep your pet at home indoors in a quiet, safe room.



If loud noises frighten or stress out your pet, and you know there will be fireworks nearby, consult your veterinarian in advance for advice on calming techniques.



If you must bring your dog to a fireworks show, make sure they are on a well-fitting collar/harness and remain on leash.



Keep your pet under close supervision and away from sparklers or glow sticks. Don't let them walk over spent materials on the ground or in the grass.



If your pet bolts and gets loose, don't panic and don't chase. Contact your local animal control officer and shelter for assistance. Learn more.
